Points:

- (A): Check box for downloading the Excel's.
- (B): For Refresh the data.
- (C): Input Controls for filtering the data.
- (D): We can Downloading and save the data in EXCEL, PDF, CSV and TEXT.
- (E): Filtering the required data through input controls fields.
- (F): Navigator for the page from Top/Bottom, Left/Right.
- (G): Status Bar Option for Number of pages in the report(i.e: Right click on the bottom line(Scroll bar place) of Report we will find status bar please select the option for showing the number of pages.
- (H): Export Document As : For downloading the data and save the report with all the tabs.
- (I): Export Current report As : For downloading the current tab data into required format.
